4. Number of volunteers.
5. Total annual program budget.
6. Does the organisation have insurance with Ansvar Insurance?

## Section B. Program details

1. Name of program.
2. Is this a recurring project?
3. When was it first run?
4. Program objectives.
5. Key activities and timings.
6. How will this program benefit the community?
7. Describe the demographic that this program is designed for?
8. After a person has participated in your program what sort of impact do you want to have on their life?

## Section C. Financial

1. Please provide a high level breakdown of the program budget and indicate where this grant would be used.
2. Will the program be run if Ansvar Insurance does not provide a grant, or only a partial grant? How?
3. Please list any other program partners.

## Section D. Past recipients

# Grant Application Process

In order to make a grant request you must submit a completed grant application following the format outlined in this document. You may be contacted if additional information is required. All applications must be received by 5pm on 11th September 2009. You will be advised of the outcome of your application by 1st December 2009. Payment of 2010 grants will be made in January 2010.

## Community Education Grant Categories

Ansvar Insurance supports youth oriented programs which generally fall into the following categories:

- **Empowerment and Education.** These programs provide proactive opportunities which assist in the development of positive values that lead to healthy lifestyle choices and a positive contribution to our community.
- **Outreach Programs.** Programs that support at risk youth who are already experiencing difficulties such as drug and/or alcohol abuse, through rehabilitation and/or skills training.
- **Training Programs.** For people delivering the above two programs.

Preference will be given to programs that provide young people with ongoing education and skills which will make a significant difference to their lives.

The board of Directors will review applications at the October board meeting and allocate funding for 2010 programs.

1. Applications must be received by 5pm on 11th September 2009. **Applications received after this time will not be considered.**
